## GETTING STARTED

### STEP 1: THE PURCHASE

#### DVD SET

There are 4 discs with the DVD Set.  
Disc 1 - Pdf's of the lesson (CD-Rom)  
Disc 2-4 - the media files for each lesson (DVD)

#### DOWNLOAD

With a Super Church 2.0 download purchase you receive a link in your email. All of the files you need are in that link.



### STEP 2: BEFORE I TEACH

- Print out copies of the lessons and distribute to your volunteers. You can also email lessons to your Team Members.
- Make copies of the Small Group Curriculum and Parent Devotional for your small group leaders and parents.
- Load MP4's onto a computer in your classroom or burn them to a DVD.
- Teach the lesson.

### STEP 3: WHAT DO I NEED INSIDE MY CLASS

- A computer or DVD player
- A projector or large TV
- QuickTime or similar program (QuickTime is a free download from the internet.)

## LARGE GROUP

### Lesson Outline

- The Lesson Outline is designed to be a study guide of the lesson, for the teacher.
- It includes the Memory Verse, Bottom Line and main points of the lesson.

#### MEMORY VERSE:

- It is important to refer to the Memory Verse throughout the lesson.
- Have the children repeat the Memory Verse more than one time.

#### BOTTOM LINE:

- You want the Bottom Line to stick. Repeat the Bottom Line often throughout the lesson.
- All of your Team Members should know both - the Bottom Line and the Memory Verse.

### Schedule

- The Large Group Schedule is designed to help you communicate with your Team Members.

THIS SCHEDULE WAS DESIGNED FOR YOU TO GET THE MAXIMUM BENEFIT OF EACH PORTION OF THE LESSON.

#### WHO DOES WHAT?

- The Schedule lists each part of the service.
- The Lead Teacher should assign each part of the service and write it on the Schedule.
- After assigning parts, distribute copies of the schedule to all of your Team Members, including your A/V Team.
- This helps your Audio/Visual Team know when they need to be ready for their segments.






## LARGE GROUP


### *Motion Comic*

- Kids love the Motion Comic, The Adventures of the Masked Hero.
- Every week they see four new panels similar to the Sunday morning comics. It is an Ice-Breaker to start the day.
- The main character, Johnny, is your average 9-year-old boy with a powerful imagination.
- When he puts on his cape and bandana, he becomes “The Masked Hero” in his mind, but to the rest of the world he is just Johnny.



THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE MOTION COMIC IS TO GRAB THE KIDS ATTENTION AND TO INTRODUCE THE LESSON TO YOUR CLASS.

- For each Motion Comic I have written leading questions for you to ask, that help you introduce the lesson.
- Make sure the Team Member watches the Motion Comic ahead of time and practices asking the questions.

## **LARGE GROUP**

### DRAMA SKIT

- Most of the Live Drama Skits involve two characters - the Teacher and the Drama Character.
- This makes it easy for any size church.
- There are scripts for each Drama Skit.
- You can email the scripts to the Team Member so they can memorize their lines.
- Challenge your Team Members to raise the bar and memorize their lines.

#### **DRAMA CHARACTERS**

##### DR. RUBENSTEIN

- An eccentric inventor whose inventions help Christians.
- Costume: wig, moustache and lab coat

##### LOW PRICED LOU

- A cheezy salesman or conman who always has something to sell you.
- Costume: horn rimmed glasses and sportcoat with tie

##### MARTHA STEWIE

- A narrow-minded, judgmental perfectionist who thinks she is always right using crafts and home decorating ideas to make her point.
- Costume: wig and apron

##### NOT TOO BRIGHT

- An over the top “unbeliever” who always does the opposite. He does not read the Bible because he is “Not Too Bright.”
- Costume: clown wig and t-shirt with “Not Too Bright” printed on

##### DETECTIVE DRAKE

- A hard-nosed police detective who investigates the Bible.
- Costume: trench coat and hat

## LARGE GROUP

### OBJECT LESSON

- Be visual. When teaching kids have a prop in one hand and a Bible in the other hand.
- Each lesson has an object lesson that uses everyday objects.
- Each object lesson has a detailed description of how to present this lesson.
- It is easy to copy or email to your team members.



## LARGE GROUP

### SHORT FILM APPLICATION

- This generation is a media generation.
- The Short Film is designed to enhance your message and make it relevant for kids.
- This specialized media element will keep the attention of your whole class.

AFTER THE SHORT FILM IS VIEWED IT IS IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW UP AND TIE THE SHORT FILM TO YOUR LESSON.

- For every Short Film we have written a Short Film application.
- It is in Pdf format, and you can email this to your teacher as a follow-up to the lesson.
- Make sure that your Team Members watch the Short Film before class, and practice the Short Film Application.

- (It could be two kids, ten kids or the whole class.)




## LARGE GROUP DIGITAL REVIEW


## LARGE GROUP

### PROP LIST

- The Prop List is at the end of each Large Group pdf file.

THE PROP LIST COMPILES ALL OF THE PROPS AND SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR THAT LESSON.

- This is a great way to get others involved - not in the classroom.
- There may be people who cannot serve in the classroom, but have time during the week to make copies and gather props.

## SMALL GROUPS

### *Why Small Groups Are Important?*

- Small Group is a time for kids to ask questions and build relationships with each other.
- It is vital that the kids make friends at church. This is what Small Group is all about.
- If kids do not make friends at church, we will lose them when they become teenagers, because teens want to hang with their friends.

### *Pre-Service Activity*

- This is an icebreaker activity, which includes questions to use before church starts.
- It's great for new Team Members or coaches, because it gives them something to motivate their kids to interact with each other.

### *Bible Story*


- The best way to teach kids to love their Bible is to get them to read their Bible.
- For kids in 3rd – 6th grade we use the NIV Bible and each child takes a turn reading a verse.
- We suggest using a picture Bible for the 1st and 2nd graders.

### *Small Group Lesson*

- We have included a third object lesson reinforcing the bottom line.
- We have made it easy for your Small Group leaders, because we give them the lesson, the point to make and questions to ask for discussion.
