2. BIBLE TIME

READ:

• Genesis 1:1-5

MAIN POINT:

The Bible says, "The fool has said in his heart there is no God." People who don't believe in God think the world was just a big accident. Christian believe that God created the world and everything in it. The world didn't just happen, it was designed by God. When you come to God you must believe that "God is." (Hebrews 11:6) In other words you must believe that God is real, that He exists.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

- I. Who created God? (He always was)
- 2. Does everyone believe these verses? (no)

DISCUSS:

- Talk about how foolish it is to believe the world was an accident.
- Talk about some things that are too detailed to be an accident.

3. FAMILY TIME

MAIN POINT:

We simply believe that God is.

WHAT YOU NEED:

• Family favorite dessert

WHAT YOU DO:

- For dinner have your kids favorite dessert, but keep it hidden from them.
- When you start dinner let your family know that you have their favorite dessert for them.
- When dinner is finished pull out the hidden dessert.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

- I. Did you believe that I had our dessert?
- 2. Why?

DISCUSS:

That is how it is with God. Even though we can't see Him, we believe that He is.

Why did you believe I had a dessert? (Because I told you.)

We believe that God exists because the Bible tells us so.
