- C. Just walk away and hope when you come back it is still there.

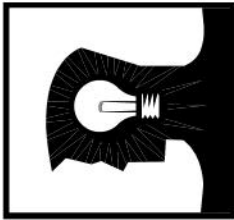

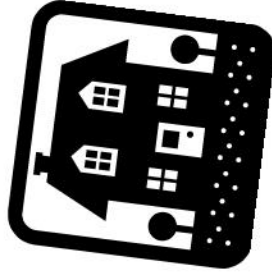

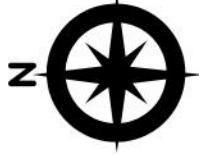
Who Lives In Your House?
